

ACTIVITY 3.2 - EXPLAIN HOW

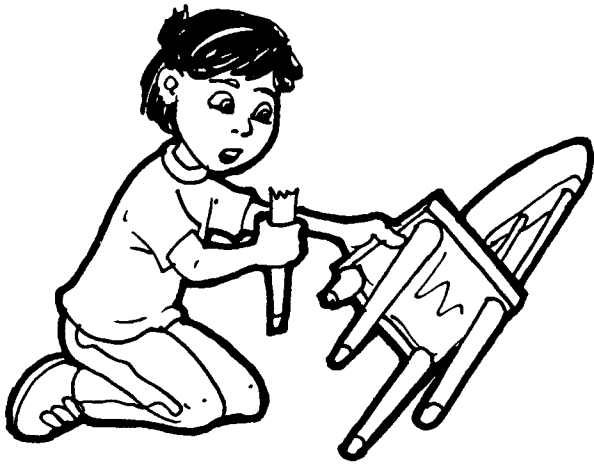
