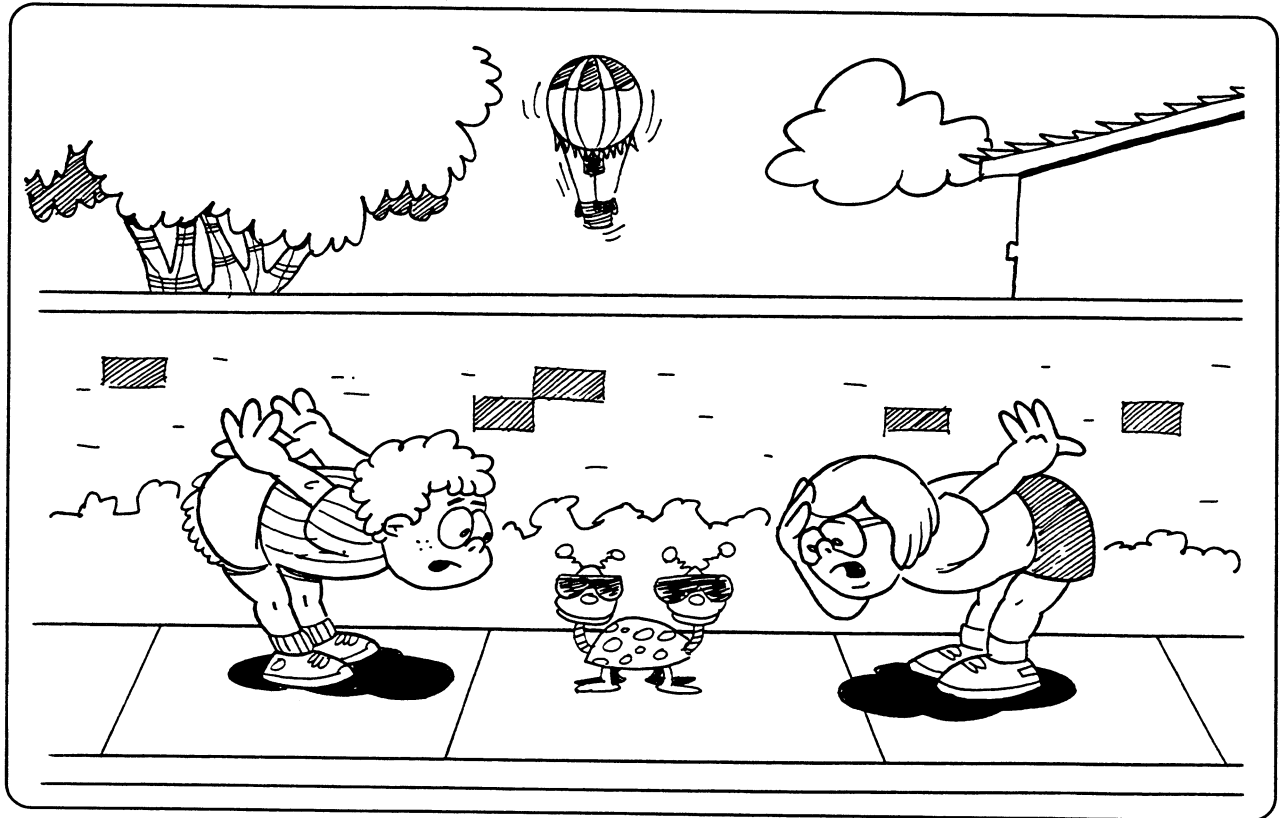


## Story 29: Two Heads are Better than One
