Ask questions to elicit descriptive information as the student talks about the action in the pictures. After the student has finished, ask him/her to tell the story one more time from the beginning. Remind the student to describe the story setting and characters when telling the story. Write down the student's story on the reproducible full-page picture pages on pages 90-100.

Jack and Jill jumped into a large bowl of fruit. "He won't find us here," thought Jack. "We'll stay here until the giant goes to sleep."


Picture D


