## **Primary Instructional Goals**

- To maintain attention during the initiation of a new topic.
- To become familiar with the Bus Story sequence
- To increase "bus" vocabulary receptively
- To increase understanding of the concept "where"
- To increase understanding of the concept of "locations"
- To follow one-step direction "Point to."
  - An array of one
  - Multiple array
  - With auditory cue
  - With visual cue
- · To increase comprehension and expressive use of concepts
- To respond expressively to single Wh-question

GOALS	CLINICIAN ACTION
To follows one-step direction 'Point to.'	Cl. holds up symbol 'Home' and says, "Time to go home."
	Cl. holds up symbol 'Backpack,' says, "Get your backpack," and points to the symbol.
	Cl. holds up symbol 'Wait,' says, "Point to <b>wait for the bus</b> ," points to the symbol, and then says "Let's get ready to go home."
To increase comprehension and expressive use of concepts	Cl. holds up symbol 'Bus Story,' says, "Point to bus," and points to the symbol. Cl. tells child(ren) to get the mini-boards.
	• Physically assist getting and pointing
	Pause 5 seconds
	Cl. asks child to tell the story with the clinician.
	Cl. holds up symbol 'Get Your Backpack,' says, "Point to backpack," and points to the symbol.
	Physically assist pointing

	Cl. holds up symbol 'Bus,' says, "Point to here comes the bus," and points to the symbol.
	Cl. holds up symbol 'Bus doors', says, "Point to <b>the doors open</b> ," and points to the symbol.
	Cl. holds up symbol 'Bus steps,' says, "Point to <b>walk</b> <b>up the steps</b> ," and points to the symbol.
